GOVERNANCE RULES FOR TTH WORKING GROUPS

- Working groups should understand and respect the goals and process of transition towns and should pursue activities in accordance with these
- At least one member of each working group should attend the steering groups meetings. Over time, the steering group will come to comprise the leaders of the working groups.
- Working groups should share their information and learning through the steering group
- Any one can propose and set up a working group as long as its aims are in accordance with the overall goals of transition towns and Transition Town Haslemere in particular. The steering group must agree to the formation of a new working group
- Financial activities - fund raising and spending - must be agreed by the steering group prior to any financial commitment
- Working groups may use the TTH logo or other branding as long as it is for activities that are in accordance with the TTH goals, and in general, should be approved by the steering group
- There is no fixed definition of Haslemere. Working groups should apply the scope guidelines as best suits their activities
- Working group activities should be as transparent as possible. Notices of meetings, agendas, minutes and other documentation should be posted to the TTH website in a timely manner
- The steering group is the body that should resolve issues of methodology, practice, etc., and provide guidance on transparency of TTH activities
- The steering group has the right to remove support from any working group that does not adhere to these governance rules
