



TERMS OF REFERENCE

Vision: "To improve the sustainability and knowledge of Climate Change in Haslemere Schools"

INITIAL STEPS

Phase 1

1. Draw up a list of all schools (to include all State and Private schools both Primary and Secondary) that will/could be included in the TTH remit.
2. Understand fully what schools are being tasked with in terms of local/central government ECO initiatives – AF to inform group
3. Research existing resources available to schools (Government, local, charitable) - AF's charity SEEd to supply
4. Research aims and achievements of other TT Education groups
5. Visit a core group of schools to establish:
 - a. Who the key point of contact on environmental affairs is within each school.
 - b. What environmental education, energy awareness practices etc are already in existence within each school programmes.
 - c. What do they feel are the gaps are and how we might be able to help the school to fill them e.g. a network? TTH members' demonstration sites, talks, workshops?
6. Initial schools to be contacted cover those where we believe there already exists a desire towards sustainability and where we have existing contacts:
 - a. St Batholomew's School
 - b. Camelsdale Primary School
 - c. The Royal School
 - d. Woolmer Hill School

Timing: To be completed by end February, 2010

Phase 2

1. Define the remit of the Working Group once the requirements from the schools have been established

Timing: To be completed by end March, 2010

Phase 3

1. Facilitate the fulfilment of the schools needs by providing a network of resources to allow the schools to make progress towards sustainability.

Timing: To be presented to interested schools in time for 2010/2011 budgeting and curriculum planning (May/June 2010)
